## Fortnite mini games to play with friends

During the first week of school, I heard a lot of talk from my then 7-year-old son about 'Fortnite.' He kept asking me if we could buy it. When we had recently moved back to the US from Germany, I was clueless - I thought it was a new LEGO theme, like Ninjago or Bionicle. After a quick internet search, I quickly decided that my son could not play the game. Although 'Fortnite' doesn't have blood and blood from other video games, it's still an active shooter that's played over the internet, where it's every man for himself and the goal is to kill each other. Whatever's true for other families, and no matter what experts say about whether there's a link between mass shooting and video games, it's a fact that 'Fortnite' sensationalizes violence that doesn't reflect the values of my house. When I announced my decision to my son, he came back with standard arguments all children have when they are banned from anything their friends do. But everyone has it, he complained. Your mothers are okay with that, why aren't you? Everyone's house rules are different, I said, and you want other toys that not everyone else has. After the disappointment sank in, he seemed to accept that he would be subject to my 'Fortnite' ban. But he was still sensitive to the possibility of me imposing my rule on his friends - or even expressing my opinion on it. It would be embarrassing because their mothers are okay with it, he said, with extra emphasis on the last part. In the end we brainstormed some alternative things to play when his friends came across our house, like LEGO or football. I assumed the case was settled. But I began to wonder if I actually cost him his social life. When my son told me that 'Fortnite' was all his friends were talking about, I had my suspicions that he exaggerated just to gin up my sympathy. Then we had his friends over at his birthday party. It was true! His friends even hovered a little bit about it, right in front of my son. One boy explained, for example, that when his birthday rolled around, he wanted a 'Fortnite' theme party where they would play the game all the time. Oh yes? How many controllers do you have? I asked. Two, he said. So you invite only one guest? No, we can take turns. It sounds like a big birthday party - only two plays and everyone else stares at a screen. Remembering my son's plea not to bother him, I let the conversation stop there. In the absence of 'Fortnite', the kids went down to the basement and played with the other assortment of toys we had down there. I didn't see the boys for the rest of the party. I see this pattern play out over and over again: When my son's friends come to the house, they first complain and are bored because I won't allow them to play violent, first-shooter video games. (I'm not even one of those moms who hates video games either! My kids got the Nintendo NES Classic for Christmas a few years with all the old favorites, including the original Super Mario Brothers. I'd rather have them shoot fireballs at turtles and throw at mushrooms than chase each other with a tommy gun.) They whine a little. Then they end up finding something else to do. Riding bikes, ball games or building with LEGO bricks - my 'Fortnite' ban has forced them to find more active and imaginative ways to play. One by one, my son's friends have come around. On a beautiful day last fall, a neighbor boy came over wanting to play. It wasn't long before I heard the dreaded question: You don't have 'Fortnite' here? Nope, I replied. Why not? It's not for us, I said. Can we go to my place to play it?, he asked. No, I'd rather play outside, my son said, and began cycling outside. I tried to keep my pride in it. The boy actually went back to his house and returned with a Nintendo Switch. He put it up in my garage, next to where I was fixing a seat on my daughter's bike. I found it extremely strange that he would rather sit next to an old (but still cool!) mother while my son rode his bike. But after a while, he joined my son outside for the rest of the time. In the end, I'd like to think they had more fun there than they would have if they had been playing with the Switch. And now, my son is the one who stops me from burying my face in a screen, too. When he finds me staring at my phone or watching TV, he complains and tells me to get off. He's the one who starts family game night most of the time. So if my 'Fortnite' ban costs him a few friends at school - and I don't think it does - but helps me stay in touch with my son at this critical age, I think it's worth it. Enter a friend's Epic Games name or email, and then send the request. You can also add friends outside fortnite using the Epic Games app. To add a friend through the app, choose Friends & Add a Friend. Type the player's e-mail address, and then select Send. Fortnite is a free game for PC, Xbox One, PlayStation 4, Nintendo Switch and mobile. If you prefer to play with friends instead of strangers, you can learn how to add friends on Fortnite. You can even play with someone who doesn't have a game console using split-screen mode. When you play Fortnite on a console, you immediately have the option to collaborate with friends who also use the console. For example, if you play on Xbox One, One, can invite your Xbox Live friends. PlayStation 4 owners can play with their PlayStation Network friends. Fortnite is a cross-platform game, which means PC players can play with Xbox players, Nintendo Switch players can play with mobile players, etc. To play with a friend who uses a different platform, add them via the Fortnite or Epic Games launcher PC app. When Fortnite was launched, Sony prevented PlayStation 4 users from playing with Xbox One and Switch players. The ban is gone, so you can really add friends on Fortnite from any platform, no matter what platform you use. Fortnite makes it easy to send friend requests to friends on other platforms, and you can also send them to people you've played with recently. To add friends on Fortnite, start Fortnite and create a Save the World, Battle Royale, or Creative lobby. The type of lobby you create doesn't matter. Friends added to Save the World mode are also available in Battle Royale and vice versa. To play the game as soon as your friend accepts your request, create a lobby for the mode you want to play to save time. Click or tap the friends icon that looks like human silhouettes if you're playing on PC or mobile. Press the display button on Xbox One (looks like two boxes), on the Nintendo Switch, press the button; and press the touchpad button on PlayStation 4. If you're playing on PC or mobile, click or tap ADD FRIENDS. Xbox One users, tap X. Nintendo Switch users, tap Y. PlayStation 4 users, tap Square. Select the ENTER DISPLAY NAME OR E-MAIL and enter your friend's epic game display name or their email. Xbox One users can access this field by pressing A. Nintendo Switch users use the B button. PlayStation 4 users press X. You will also find suggested friends and latest players on this menu. To send a friend request to someone you recently played Fortnite with, select them from this menu. If you enter your friend's display name or email address correctly, you'll see a message sent by a friend request. If your friend accepts the request, they'll appear on your friends list in the EPIC FRIENDS section. When you add friends to Fortnite, you add them to your Epic Games account. Epic is the developer and publisher of Fortnite, and they have a PC app that acts as a launcher for the PC version of Fortnite and a store where you can buy other titles. If you have a friend playing Fortnite and you want to add them to play later without actually starting the game, use the Epic Games app on your PC. If you use this method, you don't need to start Fortnite just to add any. When you add friends through the Epic starter, you can easily play across platforms with all your friends, whether they're playing on Xbox One, PlayStation 4, PC, or mobile. To add a Fortnite friend through Epic click Friends & Add a Friend. Enter the second email address, and then click Send. Thanks for letting us know! Tell us why! Why!
